### **DIRECTOR**

As someone with excellent knowledge of the gay community and gay men's sexual health, you excel at building and maintaining professional relationships, creating consensus and driving momentum with province-wide projects. This may be your next career move if you are ready for a new level of challenges and engaging projects. This role will utilize your strong analytical thinking skills and your ability to assess complex community and social issues as you continue the GMSH strategic plan implementation.

Your focus in this role will lay with the three broad strategies of GMSH: 1) networking and community mobilization; 2) campaign and resource development; and 3) skills-building and training. This coming year will be exceptional as we prepare to launch our next campaign (focused on party drugs and sexuality). Our compelling campaigns stretch across Ontario into urban, suburban, rural and remote communities, each with varying resources along with complex and unique challenges when it comes to healthcare services, educational resources and community supports. In addition to our campaigns, we host related events, meetings and an annual symposium.

This role will keep you engaged as you look after the day-to-day management, administration and ongoing development of our work. This opportunity will appeal to you if you have an established background with people supervision and project management, along with proven program development, delivery and evaluation skills. You thrive in a role which is focused on holistic health-system responses to marginalized communities, continuous community engagement, ideas sharing and knowledge exchange. This role will further strengthen your program and supervision expertise while providing you with ongoing connection to our stakeholders, members, and communities across the province.
