In 2014 PLDI™ exhibited "Peters Tree" The art installation consists of a stylized forest with thirty (30) large full colour photo portraits of HIV positive people linked together by bands of light. In each tree there is photo portrait and only one word sharing the personal impact of their HIV diagnosis.

Peter's Tree was first unveiled on World AIDS Day December 1, 2015 in Toronto at the Anglican Arch Diocese World AIDS Day service. It traveled subsequently to Ottawa for the opening of the new AIDS Committee of Ottawa, Central East Opening Doors and the Ontario AIDS Network 20th anniversary Honour Roll.

Its 2016 and our PLDI™ community has grown, even if you were in the first exhibit feel free to be in the second one too.
