- University degree or equivalent with a specialization in Social Work, Nursing, or Addictions.
- Experience with staff supervision within a non-profit organization.
- Minimum five years experience providing case management and/or services to those marginalized, struggling with addictions, mental health and/or sexuality.
- Demonstrated excellence in written, presentation, verbal and interpersonal communication skills.
- Strong leadership, supervisory and project management skills.
